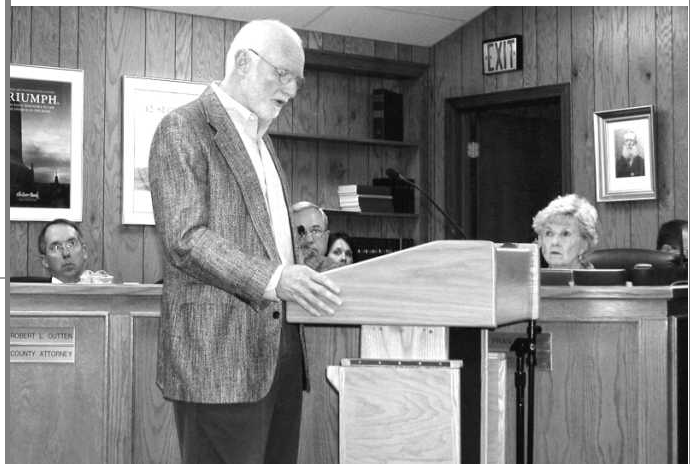
The Outer Banks Community Foundation has met the nation's highest philanthropic standards for operational quality, integrity and accountability.

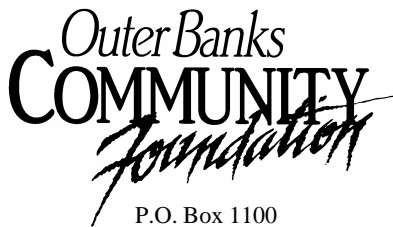
- ◆ The Foundation helped donors award over \$205,000 in **scholarships and grants** in 2006.
